HCESD #24 Administrative building: MARTINEZ informed the board that MA is working on possible design of Administration, Site layout has been completed (approx. 2.5 acres), detention capacity for proposed site, working with the Chief on the program needs, working with BD Realty to acquire desired land.

Station 21: MARTINEZ updated the board that TXDOT approved a permit extension, waiting for terms of extension, S&G currently investigating onsite detention, right of way access and development requirements with Harris County and City of Houston ETJ.

Ricardo MARTINEZ also presented the board with an updated exterior color for Station 11 and wanted their feedback if the stations exterior should remain the same or be changed. All five commissioner approved the exterior color as red with a lighter color brick.
