

Bergheim VFD Response Information for Insurance Purposes

The following information is provided to you and/or your insurance company to use for insurance purposes. All Kendall County fire departments participate in a mutual aid joint agreement. In the event of a confirmed structure fire, the fire department that is designated as the first responding department will be dispatched, and then the next two closest fire departments will be dispatched to assist. If additional department's help is needed, the Incident Commander will request additional departments be dispatched. Bergheim VFD's response time is generally 6 to 16 minutes, depending on the distance from the station to the location. Bergheim VFD can respond with:

Command-31

This custom Command vehicle is built on a Ford F-250 body with four-wheel drive, featuring a rear command module with a slide out tactical board. The Command vehicle is made for command & control at an emergency, as well as transporting first responders.



Engine 31

Engine 31, a pumper/tender, carries 1800 gallons of water, has a compressed air foam system, a quick dump system, and is capable of transporting a 6-man crew. It is the first truck dispatched to a structure fire.



Engine 32

E-32 holds 1250 gallons of water and is equipped with a compressed air foam system, 1250 gallon per minute pump, and extrication tools.



Tender 33

T-33 is a "Water on Wheels" truck - delivering water to a fire scene - with a 2000 gallon capacity and a 1000 gallon per minute pump.



Brush 32

B-32 is used to fight brush fires, holds 500 gallons of water and is equipped with a foam system.



Brush 33

B-33 holds 418 gallons of water and is also used to fight brush fires.



Squad 36

S-36 responds to first responder calls as well as rescue. It carries a variety of equipment.
