- Posess current certification as an EMT or higher level EMS provider.
- Have at least one year of experience in providing EMS as an EMT or higher-level EMS provider.
- Provide documentation of instructional time. Instructional time can be for any EMS certification program, taught within the last year. 20 hours will eventually be needed.
- Supply a letter of recommendation from either a PA Department of Health Accredited Training Institute Director/Administrator or an EMS Certification Coordinator in advance of the course.
