Population/ Household Changes:

Employment:

The fire district has seen a slight decrease in the last 12 years. Much of this seems to be due to the loss of Manufacturing jobs within the region (see Figure 2 for details). Other sectors such as Utilities, Retail and Public Administration (i.e. schools, police) have increased over time to counter-balance this loss in jobs. In addition, the area has remained slightly below the countywide average in terms of unemployment as shown in Table 3.



Socio-Economic Conditions:

The area has seen it income growth keep pace with the rest of the county in terms of median household income (Table 4). In regards to racial composition, the area has nearly tripled in minority population since 1990. The Census defines minority as: Black, Asian American, American Indian or Alaskan Native (Table 5).
