RESOLUTION 2017-11

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE WOOD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR ADDITIONAL INSPECTION SERVICES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Wauseon has a Building Inspection Department certified by the Ohio Board of Building Standards ("OBBS") pursuant to Ohio Revised code Section 3781.10(E); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2017-10, the City of Wauseon entered into an agreement with the Wood County, Ohio Building Inspection Department pursuant to which Wood County will assist the City in enforcing the Residential Building Code of Ohio for One, Two and Three-Family Dwellings; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wauseon desires to have Wood County, by and through its Building Inspection Department, provide, from time-to time, additional inspection services to be paid on AN hourly basis; and

WHEREAS, Wood County, by and through its Building Inspection Department, is willing to provide such services pursuant to a proposed Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and for the further reason that the City is in need of immediate further residential building code inspection and enforcement services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1.

That the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the Agreement for additional inspection services, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.


Section 2.

That the Mayor is further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary therefore.


Section 3.






