RESOLUTION 2017-17

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN EMPLOYEE SEPARATION AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Brian Courtney is currently employed as a Sergeant with the Wauseon Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Courtney has decided to resign from the Wauseon Police Department effective no later than September 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City and Sgt. Courtney desire to enter into a Separation And General Release Agreement (“Separation Agreement”) governing the terms of Sgt. Courtney’s resignation; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:


Section 1


That the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized to enter into the Separation Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Clerk of Council.


Section 2




