RESOLUTION 2017-20

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC SERVICES DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE REFUSE FRANCHISE, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 713.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Wauseon provides that the Director of Public Service shall at the direction of Council advertise for bids for a refuse franchise; and

WHEREAS, the current refuse franchise will expire on November 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the collection of refuse is necessary in order to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City because the current franchise will expire on November 30, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1.

That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for refuse collection franchises provided in Section 713.03 et. seq. of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Wauseon.

Section 2.

The Mayor or her designee is hereby authorized to accept the lowest and best bid for the refuse franchise.

Section 3.

That the Mayor or her designee is further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary therefore.


Section 4.

That the franchise shall be granted for a period of five (5) years.


Section 5.






