RESOLUTION 2017-26

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR WATER RECLAMATION PLANT DEWATERING IMPROVEMENTS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID, AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER

WHEREAS, the Wauseon Water Reclamation Plant operates a biosolids land application program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2015-11, ARCADIS, on behalf of the City, conducted a biosolids study; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to implement certain Water Reclamation Plant dewatering improvements pursuant to the plans and specifications prepared by ARCADIS, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, the funds for implementing the Water Reclamation Plant dewatering improvements have been budgeted by Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1.

That the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized to advertise for bids pursuant to Ohio Law and the Codified Ordinances of the City of Wauseon, Ohio, for the implementation of Water Reclamation Plant dewatering improvements pursuant to the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.


Section 2.

Upon compliance with the State of Ohio and the Codified Ordinances of the City of Wauseon, the Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the lowest and best bid in the amount budgeted for this purpose.


Section 3.

That the Mayor is further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary therefore.




