RESOLUTION 2017-29

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING NOVEMBER 25, 2017 AS SMALL BUSINESS SATURDAY AND SUPPORTING AWARENESS OF SMALL BUSINESS SATURDAY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, City Council desires to join the Toledo Regional Chamber of Commerce in celebrating our local small businesses and the contributions they make to our community; and

WHEREAS, in this region there are more than 12,800 businesses with fewer than 100 employees according to the U.S. Census Bureau; and

WHEREAS, these small businesses comprise 96.7 percent of all firms in the region; and

WHEREAS, nationally small businesses accounted for more than 60 percent of net new jobs over the past 24 years according to the U.S. Small Business Administration; and

WHEREAS, small businesses often offer many unique products and services, as well as local crafts and specialties; and

WHEREAS, small businesses contribute to our communities by providing goods, creating jobs, and supporting the overall health of our economy; and

WHEREAS, businesses, public entities and other organizations across the nation have established the Saturday after Thanksgiving as Small Business Saturday; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and because Small Business Saturday is to occur on November 25, 2017;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1

That Saturday, November 25, 2017, shall be and hereby is recognized in the City of Wauseon as SMALL BUSINESS SATURDAY.


Section 2


The residents of our community, and communities across the region are urged to support small businesses on "Small Business Saturday" and throughout the year.




