## ORDINANCE NO. 2018-12

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1142.09(a) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WAUSEON

WHEREAS, Section 1142.09(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Wauseon permits signs “not exceeding 25' x 32' in areas that are customarily associated with residential use”; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to allow signs of the same intended square footage of 800 square inches be permitted in areas that are customarily associated with residential use, regardless of dimensions;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:


Section 1.

That Section 1142.09(a) be amended to provide as follows:

“(a) Signs not exceeding 800 square inches in areas that are customarily associated with residential use and that are not of a commercial nature, such as signs giving property identification, names or numbers or name of occupants, signs or mailboxes or newspaper tubes and signs posted on private property relating to private parking or warning the public against trespassing or danger from animals.”


