ORDINANCE 2018-6

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A JOB CREATION INCOME TAX CREDIT TO CLEANLITES RECYCLING, INC; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City is authorized under Ohio Revised Code Section 718.15 and Wauseon Codified Ordinance Section 191.064 to grant a refundable credit against its tax on income to a taxpayer to foster job creation in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to grant a refundable credit against its tax on income generated by Cleanlites Recycling, Inc. ("Cleanlites"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 718.15, and as authorized by City of Wauseon Resolution 2018-21, the City of Wauseon and Cleanlites have entered into a Local Job Creation Tax Credit Agreement specifying all the conditions of the credit, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and in order to incentivize Cleanlites to create an operation in Wauseon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1.

That a refundable credit against City's tax on income shall be and hereby is granted to Cleanlites pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement entered into between the City and Cleanlites.

Section 2.

That this Ordinance be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of health, safety and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon and more specifically to allow for immediate proper legal advice to be rendered to the Mayor and the City Council of Wauseon and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.


