RESOLUTION 2018-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2014 MAUMEE VALLEY EAST CHIP CONSORTIUM PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF HENRY, CITY OF NAPOLEON, COUNTY OF FULTON, AND CITY OF WAUSEON; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is more and more difficult for low and moderate-income citizens in the City of Wauseon to afford safe and decent housing; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) provides financial assistance to local governments under its Program Year 2018 Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) program for the purpose of addressing local housing needs; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, the City of Wauseon entered into The Maumee Valley East CHIP Consortium (MVECC) 2014 Partnership Agreement with the County of Henry, the City of Napoleon, and the County of Fulton, to participate in the CHIP program; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a Second Amendment to the 2014 agreement so that it may participate in the 2018 CHIP program, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and because the current Agreement expires on May 4, 2018;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1.

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into the Second Amendment, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council, in order that the City may participate as a partner with the County of Henry, the City of Napoleon, and the County of Fulton, in the 2018 CHIP program.


Section 2.

That the Mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.


Section 3.




