RESOLUTION 2018-14

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A JOBSOHIO GRANT AGREEMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Hill Manufacturing, Inc., a business located in the City of Wauseon, has received a \$100,000 grant award from JobsOhio; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary, or order for Hill Manufacturing, Inc. to receive the grant funds, that the funds be deposited into the City of Wauseon Revolving Loan Fund and then paid out to Hill Manufacturing, Inc. pursuant to a JobsOhio Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the JobsOhio Grant Agreement is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires that the City enter into to the JobsOhio Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and because the grant funds will be available shortly and will need to be dispersed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1.

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into the JobsOhio Grant Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.

Section 2.

That the Mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

Section 3.

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
