RESOLUTION 2018-17

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH REGION VII EDUCATION SERVICE CENTER, TEXAS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to sections 8.001 and 8.002 of the Texas Education Code, and section 791.011 of the Texas Government Code, a Regional Education Service Center in Texas is permitted to provide competitively bid cooperative purchasing services to political subdivisions in other states, including cities in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code sections 9.48 and 2744.01, the City of Wauseon is permitted to participate in competitively bid cooperative purchasing services provided by other states, including Texas; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires that the City of Wauseon enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the Texas Region VIII Education Service Center for competitively bid cooperative purchasing services (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Agreement is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and because the City wishes to access immediately the available bid cooperative purchasing services which will save the City thousands of dollars;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1.

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into the Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.

Section 2.

That the Mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

Section 3.

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
