### **RESOLUTION 2018-26**

# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LEASE WITH THE WAUSEON VILLAGE EXEMPTED SCHOOLS FOR A PORTION OF THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF NORTH SHOOP AVENUE AND LINFOOT STREET; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Wauseon is the owner of the property located at the Southwest corner of North Shoop Avenue and Linfoot Street ("Property") and formerly occupied by the Ohio Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Wauseon Exempted Village Schools desire to lease a portion of the Property for use as a vehicle maintenance facility; and

WHEREAS, the City, pursuant to its authority granted under section 3.01(a)(8) of the

Wauseon Charter, desires to enter into a Lease of a portion of the Property with the Wauseon Exempted Village Schools; and

WHEREAS a copy of the Lease is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, on behalf of the City, should be authorized to enter into the Lease with the Wauseon Exempted Village Schools; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and because the Wauseon Exempted Village Schools is in immediate need of the facility to conduct maintenance of its buses and other vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:

### Section 1.

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into the Lease with Wauseon Exempted Village Schools, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.

# Section 2.

That the Mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intention of this resolution.

## Section 3.

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
