RESOLUTION 2018-27

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HOLIDAY PAY FOR CERTAIN PART-TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, certain part-time employees of the Wauseon Police Department and Fire Department do not receive holiday pay (time-and-a-half) when working on a City-recognized holiday; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires that auxiliary, part-time dispatchers, and part-time patrolman in the Police Department, and part-time Firefighters, EMTs, and Paramedics in the Fire Department receive holiday pay when working on City-recognized holidays; and

WHEREAS, the City-recognized holidays for which such holiday pay would be paid are as follows: New Years' Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and in order for the holiday pay take effect prior to the next holiday;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Wauseon as follows:

Section 1.


Commencing with the effective date of this Resolution, auxiliary, part-time dispatchers, and part-time patrolman in the Police Department, and part-time Firefighters, EMTs, and Paramedics in the Fire Department shall receive holiday pay (time-and-a-half) when working on City-recognized holidays.

Section 2

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.


