ORDINANCE NO. 2018-37

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A WAGE INCREASE FOR FULL-TIME NON-UNION EMPLOYEES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Wauseon provides for monetary compensation for its employees;
and

WHEREAS, City Council believes that the rates of compensation for its full-time, non-union employees should be modified; and

WHEREAS, the City believes those modification should take place on January 1, 2019;
and

WHEREAS, the proper payment of its City employees is necessary to ensure the proper functioning of the City of Wauseon; and

WHEREAS, this measure is therefore declared to be an emergency measure necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Wauseon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:


Section 1.

That effective January 1, 2019, the wages of all full-time, non-union employees shall be increased by 2%.


Section 2.
