RESOLUTION 2018-6

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TETRA TECH, INC. FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Wauseon has previously issued a request for statement of qualifications pursuant to R.C. 153.66 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed the statement of qualifications and evaluated the statement of qualifications provided to the City by various engineering firms; and

WHEREAS, Tetra Tech, Inc. has been found to be a professional design and engineering service firm that is highly qualified; and

WHEREAS, Tetra Tech, Inc. has supplied an Agreement for Professional Services for the City of Wauseon; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1.

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement for Professional Services with Tetra Tech, Inc. pursuant to the proposal on file in the office of Clerk of Council.

Section 2.

That the Mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.


Section 3.

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
