RESOLUTION 2019-26

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING STEVE BROWN AS HOUSING OFFICER TO ADMINISTER THE CITY’S TAX EXEMPTION FOR COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREA; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 199.02 of the City of Wauseon’s Codified Ordinances provides that City Council shall appoint a person to serve as the City’s Housing Officer to administer the City’s Tax Exemption program for the Community Reinvestment Area; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to appoint Steve Brown to serve as Housing Officer pursuant to Section 199.02 of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and because application under Section 199 of the Codified Ordinances has been submitted to the City and it is necessary to have a Housing Officer to review and administer the application and exemption request;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1

That Steve Brown shall be and hereby is appointed to serve as Housing Officer pursuant to Codified Ordinance 199.02 to administer the City’s Tax Exemption program for the Community Reinvestment Area.

Section 2

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
