A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CLINTON TOWNSHIP FOR ZONING COMPLIANCE AND CODE ENFORCMENT SERVICES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Clinton Township desires zoning code inspection and enforcement services;
and

WHEREAS, Clinton Township desires to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Zoning Compliance and Code Enforcement with the City of Wauseon; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wauseon desires to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Zoning Compliance and Code Enforcement with Clinton Township to provide zoning code inspection and enforcement services through the City's Fire Department for Clinton Township; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Zoning Compliance and Code Enforcement is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City because of Clinton Township's immediate need for zoning inspection services;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1.

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Zoning Compliance and Code Enforcement, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council, to provide zoning code inspection and enforcement services through the City's Fire Department for Clinton Township.


