**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-2**

**AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE PAY SCALE FOR THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WAUSEON; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, City of Wauseon Ordinance 2006-25 established the rate of compensation for the Mayor, which was subsequently amended by Ordinance 2014-18; and

**WHEREAS**, the rate of compensation for the Mayor has not been increased since 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City because pursuant to Section 3.07 of the City’s Charter, any increases in wages of elected officials must be adopted prior to March 1<sup>st</sup> in a given year;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:


Section 1

That the Mayor of the City of Wauseon shall receive annual compensation of Fifteen Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$15,000.00) per year beginning January 1, 2020, payable bi-weekly.

Section 2.

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
