## ORDINANCE NO. 2019-6

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 377.04 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WAUSEON

WHEREAS, Section 377.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Wauseon provides for the inspection of low speed vehicles, under-speed vehicles, utility vehicles, and mini-trucks, and for the issuance of a Certificate of Compliance for vehicles which comply with the inspection requirements; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to provide for the rescinding of a Certificate of Compliance in the event an inspected vehicle is later determined to not be a low speed vehicle, an under-speed vehicle, a utility vehicle, or a mini-truck, or is no longer in compliance with the inspection requirements;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:


#### Section 1.

That Section 377.04 shall be amended to include a new section 377.04(g), which shall read as follows:

“(g) Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Chief of Police or his designee from rescinding a Certificate of Compliance in the event that it is determined that an inspected vehicle issued a Certificate of Compliance is not a low speed vehicle, an under-speed vehicle, a utility vehicle, or a mini-truck, as defined in this Section, or is no longer in compliance with the inspection requirements. In the event that a Certificate of Compliance is rescinded, the sticker provided by the Wauseon Police Department pursuant to Section 377.04(f) shall immediately be removed.”


