**RESOLUTION 2020-16**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO ENTER INTO ANY AGREEMENTS AS REQUIRED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wauseon is planning to construct improvements to its roadway systems; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is consider to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and for the further reason that the application for participation in the OPWC programs is due forthwith;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1.

That the Mayor or her designee be, and hereby is, authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section 2.

That the Mayor or her designee is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3.

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to request immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.


