### a. 30-minute parking spots on Main Street and Clayton Avenue

Mr. Carrow – the Town received a letter from a business located at the corner of Main Street and Clayton Avenue regarding the 30-minute parking. The reason for the 30-minute parking on Main Street and Clayton Avenue was the anticipation of another business opening in this area to allow adequate parking for the patrons. At this time the business has not opened. Mr. Carrow opened the floor for Ms. DeVore.

Ms. DeVore – the customers that visit my store do not park in the 30-minute parking spaces because they are afraid if they are over the 30-minutes they would receive a parking ticket. It takes a while for customers to shop in her store and 30-minutes just is not adequate time to do so. So a lot of my customers do not use the assigned parking or if they do park in the 30-minute parking they will move their vehicle so they do not receive

a parking ticket. Also, there were two (2) Handicap Parking on Main Street and they have been taken away.

Mr. Carrow – the reason for the removal of the handicap parking is at one time there was a resident that requested a handicap parking that lived in that area; when the resident no longer resided at that property the handicap parking was removed. This may be something that we need to revisit at a later time.

Mr. Paisley – my suggestion would be to change the 30-minute parking to 3-hour parking or no overnight parking in this area.

Lt. Scott – if there's no signage then anyone can park there as long as they would like too.

Mr. Pedigo – what if the Town removes the five (5) 30-minute parking spaces and replaces a couple of parking spots with 2-hour parking.

Mr. Paisley made a motion to recommend to Council to alter the 30-minute parking signs by altering them to 3-hour only parking, seconded by Mr. Pedigo. Motion carried unanimously.
