Standard Operating Guideline– 2000-02 Engine Room Bay Doors

Purpose: Standard rules on when the bay doors should be opened or left closed

Scope: All fire department members.

- 1. The engine room bay doors must be closed between the hours of 1200am to 0700am unless at the time of alarm, or with permission of a company officer. This will ensure that the building is secure through the night.
- 2. Any member may open the bay doors between 7am and 1159pm any day of the week. However it is that member's responsibility to ensure the station is secure after they leave.
- 3. No Bay Doors shall be opened if the outside temperature is below 55 degrees unless at the time of alarm, or with permission of a company officer. This excludes opening the door for limited periods of time, such as getting the hose out to wash your vehicle.
