Standard Operating Guideline - 01-01 Emergency Evacuation on the Fire Ground

Purpose: To establish an emergency evacuation procedure for the fire ground.

Scope: All fire department members.

- 1. Emergency Evacuation: Anytime it has become apparent to the Incident Commander that there may be a threat to life or bodily injury to firefighting personnel, the Incident Commander will declare an emergency evacuation and the following will be done:
 - A. 5 Long blasts of the apparatus air horn
 - B. Notification of Kent Center to activate the emergency evacuation signal
 - C. All personnel will report back to the unit they responded on to be counted
 - 1. The OIC of each unit will ensure all of their crew is accounted for and report back to the Incident Commander,
 - 2. If anyone is missing that information must be forwarded to the Incident Commander so a search can be conducted.
- 2. Once the area has been evacuated the Incident Commander will appoint one (1) person for each side of the structure that has an ingress/egress point to make sure no one enters.
