Shoes should be presentable and also suitable for the planned activity. These items of clothing are prohibited
 - A. Articles of clothing containing vulgar images or language
 - B. Mini-skirts or short shorts
 - C. Midriff, low cut neckline, or tank top type shirts
 - D. Low rise pants or clothing.
 - E. Torn/tattered or unwashed clothing.
- 2. This standard is designed only for planned activities. No member can be held to the standard if they responded at the time of alarm.
