Standard Operating Guideline- 98-14 Motor Vehicle Collisions

Purpose: This standard is designed to set guidelines for members who respond to PI 10-10s.

Scope: All fire department personnel.

- 1. All Fire Department personnel will wear full turnout gear when performing rescue and patient care
- 2. Before an extrication is to begin the following must be completed:
 - A. Vehicle is to be stabilized
 - B. All power to the vehicle is to be disconnected
 - C. All members participating in the extrication need to understand the plan.
- 3. While using rescue tools or when removing glass, all members will wear fire gloves or rescue gloves and safety glasses or goggles.
- 4. During patient care, all members will wear at minimum, rubber gloves. Eye protection is recommended.
- 5. All patients will be secured to a full backboard and collared prior to transport to the hospital, unless told otherwise by ALS or medical control (Another BLS crew cannot).
