Standard Operating Guideline – 14-03 Incident Credit's

Purpose: This standard is designed to set guidelines for a standard way for member's to receive credit for Incidents.

Scope: All fire department personnel.

- 1. Members responding to the scene on board apparatus will be marked on the truck and the truck number will be indicated on the report.
- 2. Members who are on the scene will be given "Truck Credit" and it will be indicated they came POV on the Report. (Please Refer to Standard Operating Guideline 98-09 Responding at Time of Alarm).
- 3. Members who respond to the station but do not go to the scene will be given station credit.
 - a. The member is required to remain in the Station unless released by an officer at the Station or the OIC.
 - i. If no Officer is present than permission must be obtained from the OIC
- 4. A member will receive credit for an incident if they are not present at the incident or station for the following circumstances. In these cases credit will be listed under the "Station Credit" and the apparatus number they are assigned to will be listed.
 - a. The Member is engaged at another incident during the same time.
 - b. The Member is attending an in-company fire school and the OIC chooses not to respond.
 - c. The Member is at an approved activity onboard a piece of apparatus that was available to respond and was not sent by the OIC.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the member to make sure they are marked on the report and receive
- 6. Credit can be taken away for the following reasons.
 - a. Member fails to receive permission to leave.
 - b. Member refuses to help with duties on scene or at the station in support of the incident.
- 7. If an incident occurs and it is at the station and no apparatus actually responds all members responding will be given "Station Credit".
- 8. Questions concerning if a member is to receive credit are to be referred to the Fire Chief.
