

NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Montgomery County Emergency Service District No. 6 conducted public hearings on August 22, 2017 and September 12, 2017 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Montgomery County Emergency Service District No. 6 from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 6.16 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.1000 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$2,393,202.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.1000 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$2,530,249.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.1000 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$2,628,993.

The COMMISSIONERS of Montgomery County Emergency Service District No. 6 is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 19, 2017 at PORTER FIRE STATION #121, 23550 LOOP 494, PORTER, TEXAS 77365 at 12 NOON.

The COMMISSIONERS of Montgomery County Emergency Service District No. 6 proposes to use the increase in total tax revenue for the purpose of providing adequate emergency services personnel, stations, and equipment to keep pace with growth in the District.
